We hope and pray that this letter finds you doing well and enjoying the blessings the Lord pours on us on a daily basis. The last two months have been exciting. It's been Pam's first two months of busy deputation and traveling around the states.



Pamela and I have traveled 6,763 miles and have been in 15 churches in the past two months. Two of them voted to take us on for support and a few others have promised to support us. In July, we were able to help our local church with their youth conference and a few other activities while we were in town getting a home base situated before we took off on the road. Then, towards the end of July, we had such a wonderful time preaching and teaching at Salisbury Baptist Temple and their summer fun camp week. As I preached on the Love of God, many boys and girls made professions of faith and committed to love the Lord more than ever before. One of the highlight of the camp was that the church was hosting a neighborhood Bible Club under a tree in an area near the church where it was predominantly Hispanic. I was able to translate the pastor's messages into Spanish, witness to the ones that didn't understand English, and Pamela was able to witness to a Pentecostal mom who went to the Bible Club the whole week; and she professed to have accepted Christ as her savior. We praise the Lord to have had the opportunity to minister and reach the Hispanics in Salisbury, MD.



Also, we had a meeting in a church in Georgia that brought an answer to prayer. This church did not only vote to take us on for support but the pastor informed us that he had been praying about starting a baseball clinic through a missionary in the Dominican Republic as an outreach program to reach the youth with the gospel of Jesus Christ. The pastor and many members in his church had a baseball background and want to send equipment down for our baseball ministry. Well, when I heard that, I was so excited because with my baseball background, the Lord has burdened me to start a baseball outreach program in the DR once our church plant is established.

Lastly, we ask that you continue to pray that the Lord speeds our deputation and teach us what we need to learn so that we can get to the field as quickly as possible. As we mentioned in our last prayer letter, our goal is to get to the Dominican Republic during the spring of 2017. Also, please pray for Pamela. She had an infection in one of her molars, has to take care of a few things at the dentist, and she unfortunately doesn't have any insurance to cover the cost of the job. Thank you so much for faithfully supporting us and praying for us.
